Election Reform

Leveling the Playing Field:

Sweeping Comprehensive Election Reform

Together, these reforms are designed to ensure fair, transparent, secure, verifiable voting and elections.

This language is intended to be enacted via uniform amendments to the constitutions of all 50 states, as well as by an amendment to our federal constitution

Amendment Outline Draft

Part VI: After Election Day

- 1. Secured ballot storage: At the close of polls, ballots counted at the polls will be securely boxed, signed on with tallies for that batch, numbers for that batch, and moved by multi-party/no-party mixed teams, continuously filmed, to pre-arranged, long term, continuously guarded, video-recorded, secure location for storage for 3 years (other term?).
- 2. Open source (GPLv3) scanned, numbered paper ballot data on spreadsheets of tallies at each poll will become publicly available along with recorded, delayed-release livestream, with verified livestream and other filmed versions of individual poll counting, machine and manual count, process, on file and easily, freely accessible to the public. (Can anyone access, any rules..Discuss!)
- 3. Review of exit polls, consideration of data. (Part V, 3/3a)
- 4. Post-audits will rarely be needed because of the accuracy of the machine and hand count real-time tallies as election night, onsite poll audits before final tally results are accepted as 'official', under our protocol, to be done at each poll.* (As explanatory material, should this be an addendum instead of a numbered section here?)
- 5. Necessary runoff elections, if any, will be announced within 24 hours by appropriate election officials to these races.* (Which official, by what means?)
